She suffered a seizure late night on March 5, then another seizure the morning of March 6. There was nothing the vet could do to prolong her life, so we had her put down so she wouldn't suffer anymore. It was one of the hardest decisions I've ever had to make. The vet and his staff showed the utmost compassion and care in her final moments. He took care of her over the 8 years we had her. Today, March 11 I got her ashes and I still cry when I think of her.
